

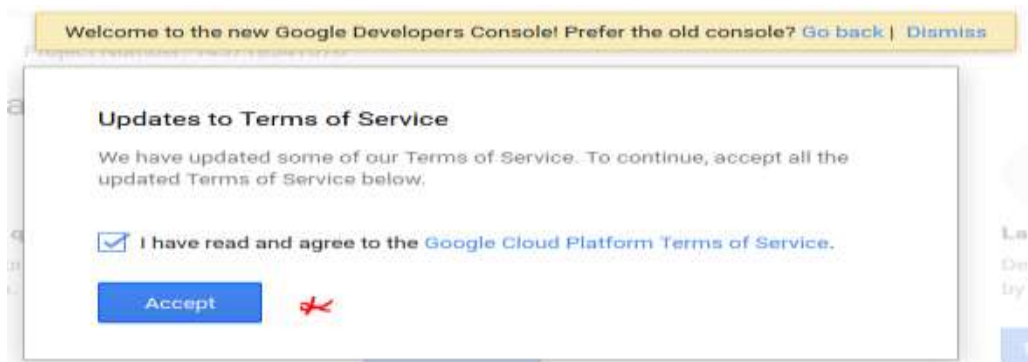
# Setup Google Analytics PRO

Thanks for purchasing Google Analytics Pro Plugin. Below is how to configure your plugin to work on your website.

---

## Step 1: Create a Project

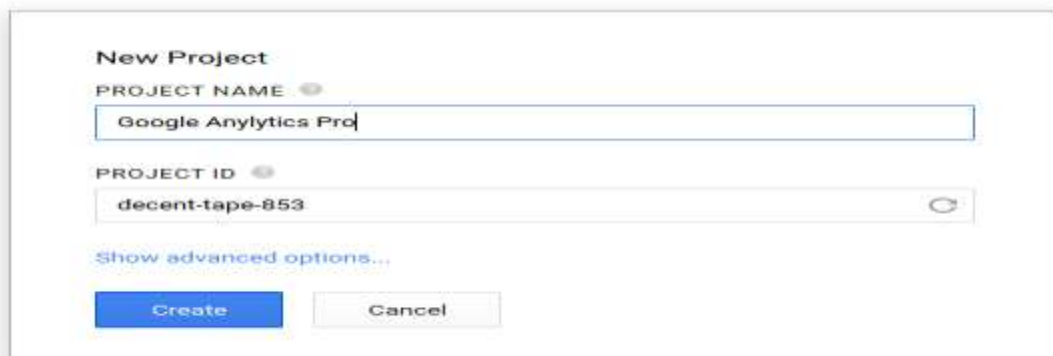
1. Visit <https://code.google.com/apis/console/>
2. Accept Google Terms and Conditions.



3. Click on **Projects** from the side menu items.
4. Click on **Create Project**.




5. Give your project a decent name and click **Create**.



## Step 2: Enable Analytics API

- From **Projects Dashboard** click **Enable an API**.

- Type **analytics api** in the search box.
- Toggle the **OFF** button at the far right to turn on the Analytics API.

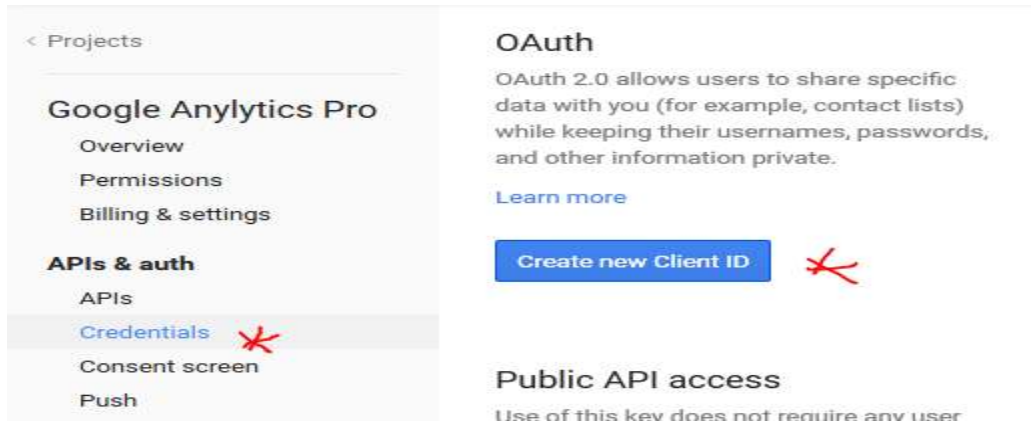

13. Configure the pop up box exactly like the image below. Replace <http://www.YourOxwallSite.com> with your website address. **Note: Your URL MUST be exactly the website address you are using Google Analytics PRO Plugin on.**
